Swim

Cool off in the pool!

- The pool is open from Memorial Day to Labor Day.
- No Lifeguard is on duty.
- Please observe all pool rules posted on the pool fence.
- A lift chair is available to lower guests into/out of the pool.
- Life jackets are available for use in the pool, if needed.
- Pool heater is set at a comfortable 80 degrees.
- A changing house with a hydraulic changing table is available behind the pavilion.



Boat

Enjoy some peaceful time on the water.



- Paddle Boats, Canoes and Kayaks are available.
- Staff and Volunteers will be available for assistance in loading/unloading boats.
- Adaptable kayak loading assistance is available for guests in wheelchairs.
- Life Jackets are required for all boaters.



Fish

Try fishing in our four-acre pond!

- Our dock is wheel-chair accessible, and we have adaptive poles for guests with limited dexterity.
- Life Jackets are required for all guests under the age of 18 and recommended for all.
- Fishing is catch and release only.
- Bait available upon request (generally corn or hot dogs).



Bike

Enjoy a carefree spirit riding around the grounds.

- Bikes in a variety of youth and adult sizes are available.
- Adaptable tricycles for two are a fun way for first-time bikers to enjoy a ride.
- Helmets must be worn at all times for safety!



Picnic

- We have plenty of picnic tables indoors and outdoors for you to enjoy.
- A full service kitchen and gas grill are available to use upon request free of charge.
- Please make sure to clean up picnic areas, kitchen, and grill thoroughly when finished.
