

- ✖ **Acquired Brain Injury (ABI) is a disruption in brain function that occurs after birth. It is not hereditary, congenital, degenerative, or caused by birth trauma.**
- ✖ **Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI) is an injury that affects how the brain works and can be a result of a bump, blow, or jolt to the head, or from an object piercing the skull.**
- ✖ **The severity of a Brain Injury (BI) can range from “mild” to “severe”.**
- ✖ **Those who survive a BI can face effects lasting days to disabilities lasting a lifetime.**

THE DISCONNECT:

- ✖ **When a brain injury survivor is discharged from the hospital or rehabilitation center there are no instructions on what life will be like next.**
- ✖ **Families don't often know about the services and resources available to help the brain injury survivor.**
- ✖ **Families and/or friends don't know where to start to help their loved one(s).**
